

COPY OF PERMIT MUST BE PRESENT AT WORK SITE DURING CONSTRUCTION

1. A deposit, in an amount to be determined by Franklin County, shall accompany this application. If proper repair is made and accepted within ten (10) days, the deposit will be refunded. If proper repair is not completed within ten (10) days, Franklin County will make the repair, the deposit will be forfeited, and any additional costs will be invoiced to the applicant.
2. Approaches shall be constructed for the bona fide purpose of securing access and not for parking, conducting business, or servicing vehicles on the highway right-of-way.
3. No revisions or additions shall be made to an approach or its associated structures within the right-of-way without the written permission of Franklin County.
4. The permittee shall furnish all materials, labor, and equipment involved in the construction of the approach and its associated structures. This shall include furnishing drainage pipe of the size specified in the permit, curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk, and any other required components. Materials and workmanship shall be of good quality and are subject to inspection by Franklin County.
5. Franklin County reserves the right to make, at any time, such changes, additions, repairs, or relocations to any approach or its associated structures within the highway right-of-way as may be necessary to permit the relocation, reconstruction, widening, or maintenance of the highway and/or to provide proper protection to life and property on or adjacent to the highway.
6. Driveways and rural approaches shall conform to the plans made a part of this permit. Adequate drawings or sketches shall be included, showing the design, construction requirements, and proposed location of the approach. All approaches shall comply with the standard provisions set forth in the highway standards and development procedures for Franklin County.
7. Franklin County may change, amend, or terminate this permit, or any of the conditions herein enumerated, if the permittee fails to comply with its provisions or requirements as set forth herein.
8. During the construction of the approach(es), the permittee shall erect and maintain such barricades, signs, and other traffic control devices as may be deemed necessary by Franklin County. These devices shall conform to the current edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways. Parked equipment and stored materials shall be kept as far from the travel way as feasible. Items stored within 30 feet of the travel way shall be clearly marked and adequately protected.
9. By accepting this permit, the permittee, its successors, and assigns agree to hold Franklin County harmless from any liability arising from the installation, construction, maintenance, or operation of the approach(es).
10. If the work performed under this permit interferes in any way with highway drainage, the permittee shall, wholly at their own expense, make such provisions as Franklin County may direct to restore proper drainage.
11. Upon completion of the work contemplated herein, all rubbish and debris shall be immediately removed, and the roadway and roadside shall be left neat and presentable to the satisfaction of Franklin County.
12. The permittee shall maintain, at their sole expense, the structure or object for which this permit is granted in a condition satisfactory to Franklin County.
13. Neither the acceptance of this permit nor anything herein contained shall be construed as a waiver by the permittee of any rights granted by the Constitution or laws of the State of Idaho or the United States.
14. No work shall be started until an authorized representative of Franklin County has given the permittee notice to proceed.
15. This permit shall be void unless the work contemplated herein has been completed within sixty (60) days from the issue date.
16. Franklin County reserves the right to order the relocation or removal of any structures or facilities authorized by this permit. Such relocation or removal shall be performed at the sole expense of the permittee or its successors or assigns.
